Historical Context:

Eva, known as "The Lady of Hope," was an especially beloved figure. She grew up in a poor village and spent her childhood without much. When she came to power with her husband she devoted her time to social justice and relief for the poor. Through organizations she created, such as the Evan Peron Foundation and the Peronist Feminist Foundation, she did much to improve the lives of average Argentineans.



Preview:

Camilo is a young man who joined the Guardia – the Nicaraguan National Guard – after being abandoned by his father. While in the Guardia he is brought under the wing of Anastasio Somoza. Somoza is the dictator of Nicaragua and is commander of the Guardia. After four years in the Guardia, Camilo falls in love with a young rebel girl named Sofia. Camilo is left with a choice: Does he go with Sofia, or stay in the Guardia with Somoza and his friends?

Historical Context:

In 1967, Luis Somoza, who had been the dictator of Nicaragua for many years, died and passed his presidency off to his brother. The young Anastasio Somoza had already been a part of the Guardia for many years and knew the political system well. Somoza was only president for four years until a law forced him to step down. Just before he was forced to step down, Somoza placed himself as head of the Guardia. The Guardia served as the primary military force in Nicaragua and was regularly funded by the United States. During the 1970's, the Guardia was used for military purposes to fight against the rebel group called the Sandinistas.



Preview:

In mid-1974 a 23 year old Maria Sanchez is having a dinner party to introduce her fiancé to her family. Little does she know, her brother and his friend are secret police. Her fiancé arrives and is a part of the revolutionary left. Through a mix of flash forwards and rising tension, the family is pulled apart and their secrets unravel.

Historical Context:

Salvador Allende was the first democratically elected socialist in Latin American history. As soon as he was elected, the United States' government – led by the Nixon administration – feared for American business interests in the region. In 1973 a coup led by General Augusto Pinochet, and supported by the United States, overthrew the Allende government and declared Pinochet dictator. Shortly thereafter the terror began. Anyone against the Pinochet regime was accused of being a communist, arrested, and brutally tortured, killed, or "disappeared." Pinochet's security service, Dirección de Inteligencia Nacional (DINA), went so far as to take people right out of their homes if they suspected any sort of anti-Pinochet agenda. 60,000 were killed in South America from 1973-1989 as a result of Operation Condor.

Preview:

Esteban Ramirez is a blackjack dealer at El Riviera, the swankiest casino in Havana. Esteban is highly underpaid, but at El Riviera he deals to the highest class of Cubans and Americans. His life is two sided – he sees the life of luxury while working in the casino and in his everyday life he sees the hardships that the average person goes through. Throughout the play Esteban will be struggling to keep his political views a secret and keep his wife happy.

Historical Context:

El Riviera was the name of Cuba's prized casino in the late 1950's. Like all of Cuba's casinos, it brought in foreign tourists and served to maintain the wealth and power of Fulgencio Batista, the U.S. backed dictator of Cuba. In order to gain the attention of tourists and investors, the casinos were full of alcohol, cigars, beautiful women, and dancers, but most Cubans did not possess the luxury of spending their time at casinos. Cuba experienced vast income inequality during the time of Batista – 1.5% of landowners controlled 46% of the land. This dramatically ended, along with casino life, in 1958 when revolutionary forces led by Fidel Castro successfully overthrew the regime.
